Incident Commander Train-the-Trainer Program

Benefits of the Blue Card Program:

Standardizes hazard zone operations across the entire organization.
Creates safer incident operations.
Creates better incident outcomes - more rapid "all clears" & reduced fire damage.
Move from a test based promotional exam to a certification based process.

Maximizes the effective use of resources.
The Blue Card Program has been designed around NFPA Standards 1561 and the NFPA NIMS pro-quals 1026.
The Blue Card Program is NIMS complaint for type 4 & 5 operations.
Over the last 20+ years the Blue Card IMS has also been used to manage hazard zone work in NIMS type 1-3 incidents.

The Blue Card train the trainer program offers FD's with incredible, turn key resources that will help implement a comprehensive, local command training program at a fraction of the costs it would take a FD to produce the material/program themselves. It will also provide departments with a core group of instructors/evaluators that are now trained and equipped to deliver the Blue Card evaluation and certification process to the members of their own department or region. These new instructors can also deliver the train the trainer program to other members in their department or region, creating a larger base of instructors/evaluators.



Instructors must have at least 5 years of fire service experience. The ideal Blue Card instructor would be a Department Training Officer, Response Chief or Ranking Operations Chief (Shift Commander, District Chief, etc.). All attendees must complete the 50-hour online Blue Card class prior to the Train-the-Trainer program.

Students will be evaluated on the following command/IMT positions:

- Initial On-Scene Officer
- Incident Commander (IC)
- Incident Management Team (IMT) Member
- Sector/Division/Group Supervisor/Safety Officer
