Standard Operating Guideline

<p><u>FF-E Pump/OVF – Engine</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Operate apparatus in a safe manor• Position - pull past structure to get 3 sided view• Set pump – engage & operate pump• Initiate Accountability• Charge attack line - on officers order and ensure attack line is in operation prior to charging additional lines• Water supply – make hydrant if close enough to hand drag• FDC - Support Building Sprinkler System (ensure PIV/ OS&Y OPEN)• Exterior command assistance - advise officer of additional personnel on scene• RIT – initial (2-in/2-out) –designate as qualified members arrive• Ladder - second floor• Ventilate - advise officer you are ready and do so upon order• Back-up line – stretch along same route as initial line to back up 1st crew• Exposure protection - deck gun or 2 1/2 <p><u>Tools/Equipment</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Full PPE and SCBA• Flashlight• Portable Radio• 6 or 8-foot hook	<p><u>Officer – Engine</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Size-up - initial radio report• Establish command• 360° survey• Fire location - determine general area involved• Entry - determine initial point of entry• Initial attack – stretch or flake out line• Force entry• Search - life and fire• Direct the nozzle team - when possible the officer should take the backup position on the line to monitor conditions and direct the nozzle person.• Command - Retain operational control unless relinquished to a superior officer <p><u>Tools/Equipment</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Full PPE & SCBA• Portable radio• TIC (consider spare battery)• Ax or Halligan
<p><u>FF-E Nozzle – Engine (4th FF if Available)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Initial attack - stretch line• Forcible Entry• Search - life and fire• Suppression – confine and extinguish fire• Primary Search - fire room after knockdown• Overhaul – initial overhaul for extension <p><u>Tools/Equipment</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Full PPE and SCBA• Remaining AX/Haligan• Portable Radio• Flashlight	<p><u>FF-A Nozzle/Hydrant – BR Ambulance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Position - Stage near scene do not get boxed in• Hydrant – If engine “lays-in” make hydrant & charge on pump operators order, come up to scene• Initial attack - stretch or flake out line & advance per officer’s direction• Force entry <p><u>Tools/Equipment</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Full PPE and SCBA• Portable radio• Remaining Ax or Haligan• Flashlight
